MEMORANDUM

Reference application for affiliation to Two Years Diploma Course in ~~Early Childhood & Care Education/Elementary Teacher Education~~ with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) students in the ~~public~~ and the same for the II year, Sri Ram Institute of Education, Barwala, Sector - 28, Okhla, Delhi - 77 is hereby granted provisional affiliation for the said course(s), subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

2. The institute shall provide separate campus for running ~~the~~ ETE Course within two years.
3. Affiliation will be provisional and will be granted initially for two years, starting from academic year 2008-10.
4. During this period, if any violation is noticed or quality is not up to the mark, SCERT will be at liberty to withdraw the affiliation.
5. Institute will conform the provisions of new Master Plan-2021 or obtain NOC from DDA within next two years. The institutes which are run on land allotted by DDA for running nursery/middle/secondary/Sr. Secondary schools shall obtain permission of the DDA for running ETE/ECCE course(s) also.
6. (i) The Institution is run under a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, or by State Government, or by a Society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860).
- (ii) The Institution has been granted a No Objection Certificate by the Government of NCT of Delhi for running the ETE/ECCE Diploma Course and;
- (iii) The Institution has been accorded recognition by the NGTE
- (iv) The Institution has the approval of the MHRD/Governing Body of the Institution or any other competent authority.

- (v) The institution is managed by a Body constituted in accordance with the Scheme of Management as specified for government funded and private unaided institutions by competent authorities, laws, rules, statutes etc. in force.
- (vi) It has, for the use of trainees of ETE and ECCE, suitable and adequate physical facilities in terms of space, accommodation, sanitation, laboratories, workshops, equipment, library, reading room, playground etc. as specified by the NCTE. These facilities are liable to be physically inspected by the SCERT and affiliation will be subject to the SCERT being satisfied as to their adequacy and availability.
- (vii) It has Faculty and other employees with requisite qualifications as laid down by NCTE and as laid down by SCERT where applicable.
- (viii) It has Faculty and teaching staff appointed as per recommendations of the appropriate and competent Staff Selection Committees or Department Promotion Committees or their approved equivalents.
- (ix) The emoluments of faculty and staff are in accordance with those laid down for the corresponding posts at SCERT as approved by the NCTE Bye-Laws, the rules of the Govt. of National Capital Territory shall be in force.
- (x) It provides for teaching of subjects, course work, projects, school experience programmes, internal assessments, surveys, etc. as prescribed by SCERT for Diploma in ETE and ECCE.
- (xi) It has adequate, verifiable, audited financial resources as prescribed by the NCTE and/or commitments from Central and or State Govt. or self-generated resources in the form of Bank Deposits as prescribed by NCTE.
- (xii) It undertakes to admit trainees who have been selected through the Common Entrance Examination held by SCERT for ETE and ECCE respectively for the particular year.
- (xiii) It further undertakes not to admit any students not selected for admissions through the SCERT Entrance process and admitted by SCERT for the particular year.
- (xiv) It undertakes to abide by all rules, regulations, orders, notifications, advisories of SCERT regarding the conduct of the ETE and ECCE Diploma Courses and also the provisions as laid down in these rules. The institution shall execute a bond guaranteeing that it shall follow

the provisions of these rules and their modifications as issued from time to time.

(xv) It undertakes to charge only that amount of fees by whatever name that the SCERT notifies from time to time.

(xvi) The SCERT will take into consideration for affiliation, the report of a panel appointed for inspection of the Institution.

(xvii) The institution shall pay a fee of Rs.10,000 per year as affiliation fees to SCERT.

(xviii) In case of any dispute between trainees admitted into the institutions and the institutions conducting the course, the SCERT shall be the sole arbitrator.

(xix) Once affiliated, the institution shall report all changes in the teaching staff and all other changes that may affect the fulfilment of the conditions of affiliation to the SCERT within 3 months of the change coming into effect. Failing to do so, it will be deemed that the institution has not fulfilled the conditions of affiliation and will attract suitable action on the part of the affiliating body.

(xx) The institution shall furnish such reports, returns and other information to the SCERT as may be sought from time to time by SCERT.

(xxi) The institution shall be liable to be inspected every year for 5 years before it is considered for permanent affiliation.

Special inspections and action thereof:

i) Notwithstanding provision in xxi), the SCERT may, at any time, arrange a special inspection of an affiliated institution, as the case may be on such aspects of its functioning as may be necessary. Any serious violation of the affiliation rule/condition(s) shall attract a penalty of Rs.5000/- for the first violation, Rs.10,000/- for the second violation and Rs.20,000/- for the third violation.

ii) The SCERT may, on the basis of the report(s) made to it and after giving a reasonable opportunity to the governing body or its equivalent in case of Govt. body or its equivalent in a case of government funded agencies of the institution.

iii) If the governing body of private unaided institutions, without reasonable cause, fails to comply with a direction given by the

SCERT, the SCERT may, after considering the explanation, if any, given by the governing body, can take such further action as it may deem fit including:

- (a) ordering the suspension or withdrawal of affiliation in part or whole; and
- (b) recommending to the concerned government stoppage of aid to the institution, if applicable.

Conditions under which affiliation may be withdrawn:

- i) The privileges conferred on an institution by affiliation may withdraw in part or in whole or modified, if -
 - a) The institution has failed to comply with any of the provisions of rules, or any order, direction or instruction of SCERT has failed to observe any of the conditions of affiliation or has conducted itself in a manner prejudicial to the interest of SCERT or its standards.
 - b) The governing body of the institution neglects to perform any of the duties imposed upon it by or under the regulations made there under or has failed to comply with any order, direction or instructions of the SCERT or has closed down an affiliated institution as the case may be, a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the proposed action, the affiliation will stand cancelled and any further process will be deemed as fresh process.

ii) Consequent to the decision of the Board of Affiliation, the Director shall pass an order accordingly.

iii) Subject: Whereby an order made under sub-clause (i)(b), the rights conferred on an institution by affiliation are suspended or withdrawn in a part or in whole or modified the grounds for such suspension, withdrawal or modification, as the case may be, shall be stated in the order.

7. Subject to the conditions of affiliation and other provisions related thereto set forth in these rules, SCERT may lay down any other condition or conditions and the procedure which may be considered necessary to be adopted for affiliation to SCERT.

8. The SCERT, with the approval of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi, reserves the right to reduce the number of trainees and/or withdraw affiliation for the ETE

and/or NTT course for specified time, if the manpower planning for teachers in the National Capital Territory so demand.

9. The SCERT reserve the right to reject a request for affiliation in whole or part, including limiting the number of trainees and also imposing such other conditions it may deem fit.
10. In case of any dispute, regarding any part of these rules/condition thereof, the Govt. of NCT of Delhi shall be the sole arbitrator.
11. As per the pre-requisite of the NCTE, all institutes are required to provide a list of academic and other staff appointed for the above course by duly constituted selection committee for the course ..

The following deficiencies are required to be removed before the commencement of the course:

- 1) More furniture required for Multi purpose Hall
- 2) More material required in ASI & craft
- 3) Appointment of bonafide ..
- 4) Safety certificate for (MCD)
- 5) Separate / regular electric connection
